Rugs are drawings for floors with a strong physical and tactile presence; images are carefully nuanced and as paired down as possible.

Wools blended with linen or silk create sensual interest and thick felted yarns achieve a chunky texture. Twisted marl yarns are looped creating a random pile and solid colours often 3 or 4 shades create extra depth.

I aim to make things that are refined, carefully considered and as beautifully made as possible.
