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Isabel Fletcher is a textile artist who explores ways in which overlooked material offcuts act as portals into the craft of their industry: the traces of making are embedded in them. She highlights the craft in manufacturing, and wants the experience of engaging with her work to encourage empathy for the possessions we own. Isabel collaborates with brands such as Kvadrat and TOAST and presents work in both solo and group exhibitions, including the Design Museum's 'Waste Age' and Somerset House's 'Eternally Yours'. She participates in talks covering themes including textiles, waste, collaboration and craft in relation to sustainability in art and design and her practice. In addition, Isabel runs regular workshops which explore the creative potential of textile offcuts through the exploration of different craft processes that elevate wasted remnants.
